Diwali Celebration

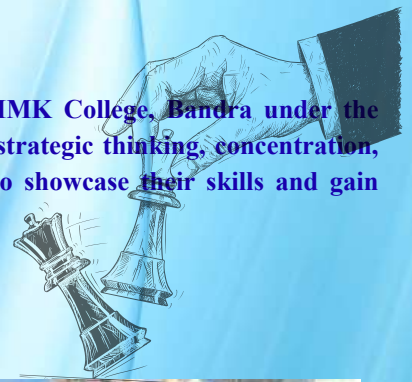

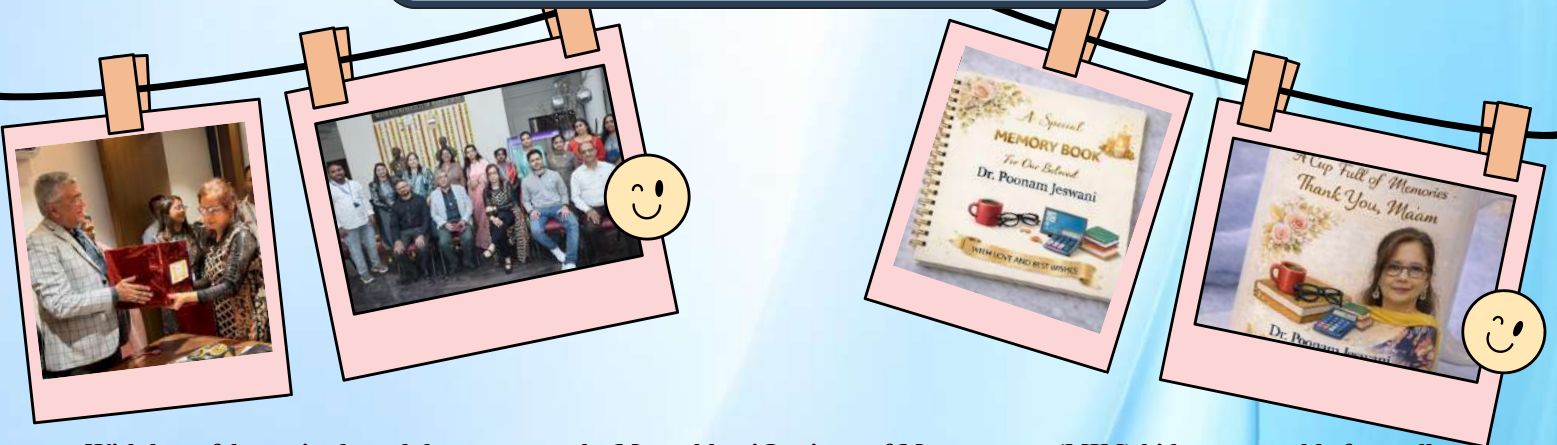


Alumni Meet 2026

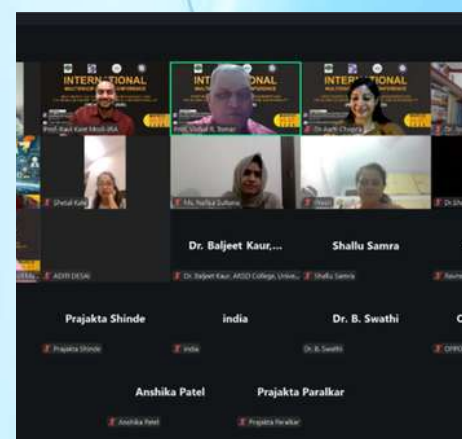
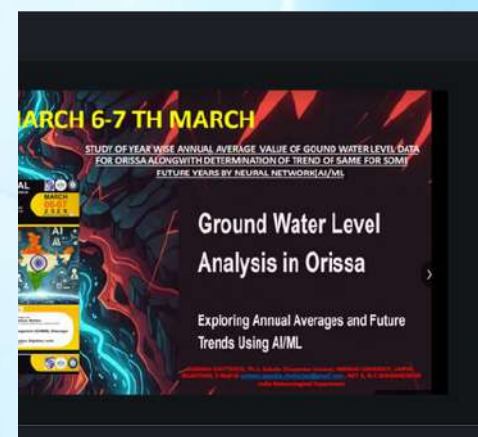
INTERNATIONAL VIRTUAL MULTIDISCIPLINARY CONFERENCE (IMCVB–VIRTUAL 2026) ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE AND DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION FOR VIKSIT BHARAT 2047

H & G H Mansukhani Institute of Management (HGHMIM), Ulhasnagar, in collaboration with Smt. Mithibai Motiram Kundnani College of Commerce and Economics (Autonomous) and Inspira Research Association, successfully organized the International Virtual Multidisciplinary Conference (IMCVB–Virtual 2026) on 6–7 March 2026 under the broad theme “Viksit Bharat 2047: Re-Envisioning Management and the Global Economy through AI, Ethics, and Sustainability.”

Day 1 of the conference focused on the sub-theme “Artificial Intelligence and Digital Transformation for Viksit Bharat 2047.” The inaugural session commenced with opening remarks by Prof. CA Kishore Peshori, followed by an address by Prof. Dr. Ravi Kant Modi. The session was graced by Chief Guest CS Dr. Shyam Agrawal and Guest of Honour Dr. Nikolina Ljepava. The session was chaired by Dr. Neelu Grover. Keynote speakers included CS Rahul Sharma, Dr. Shilpa Lodha, and CA Harshit Jain. 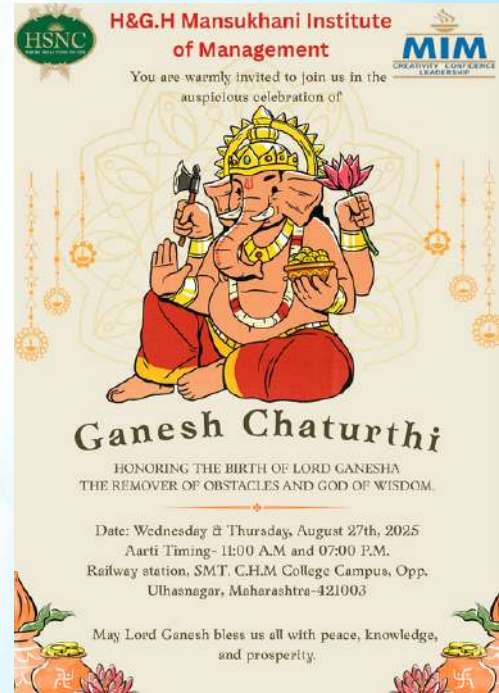
